Course Insight

The TQUK Accounting programme is suitable for business graduates wishing to enter work or are currently working in the accounting and finance sector. The course is offered online and has a duration of 18 months. Upon successful completion, graduates are granted 9 exemptions of the 14 required professional examinations with ACCA (Association of Chartered Certified Accountants).

The qualification encourages learners to critically evaluate current academic concepts, theories and research in order to address key issues in Accounting and Finance. Learners will develop an understanding of current practice together with specialist analytical skills and knowledge.

Entry Requirements

To be admitted onto this programme, learners should have an honours degree, preferably in a Business and Accounting related subject, or a professional qualification, or a degree equivalent from a recognised overseas institution. Learners should also be fluent in

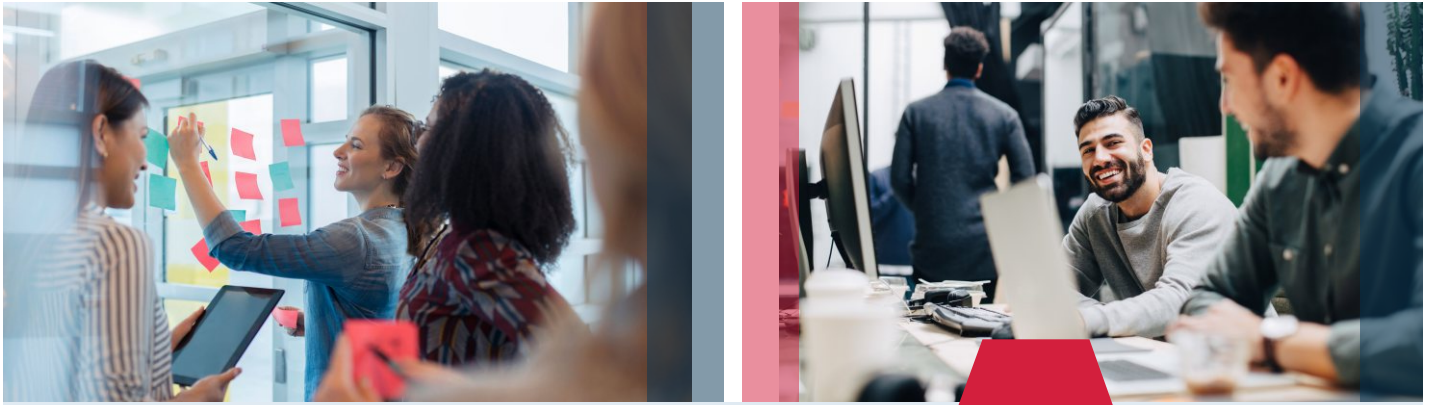
written and spoken English. Evidence should be provided where learners have studied in a University where English is not the official language. Acceptable evidence includes: GCSE /A level English, IELTS 6.5 or an equivalent qualification.

Learners who do not hold an honours degree may be accepted if they have completed Year 1 and Year 2 of an honours degree, or have a minimum of two years' work experience in a responsible role, preferably within Business and Accounting.

The recommended minimum age for this qualification is 19 years.

Assessment

This qualification is assessed through a portfolio of evidence of activities, which are developed by the College (subject to external quality assurance/verification by TQUK) and internally marked. These will include, online group discussions, written assignments, case studies, online question-and-answer sessions and mandatory final examinations at the end of each module.

Course Aims
